

Peace Child Forum Theatre Programme

Training Schedule:

- 3 Intensive days or 2 hours over 6 weeks.
- Performance can be on final day or set at a specific time.

Needs:

- Suitable space for delivering drama workshops.
- Supervising teacher or adult to be a contact person from the school or youth group.
- Identifying an appropriate group to perform for, preferably this will include peers and/or the students' year group.

Aims:

- Give young people a voice to share their experiences, thoughts and feelings on conflict and/or discrimination issues that they feel are a problem in their community.
- Build self-confidence, as well as public speaking and active listening skills through performance exercises and experiences.
- Enlighten young people to the choices they have in a conflict situation and how they can help create a more positive outcome.
- Address important conflict and discrimination issues within the community and how those issues affect the members of that community.
- Address SEAL curriculum: *'Deal with and resolve conflict effectively and fairly', 'Manage strong feelings such as frustration, anger and anxiety,'* and most importantly, *'Understand and value the differences between people, respecting the right of others to have beliefs and values different from their own.'*
