YOUTH SUSTAINABILITY ACTION FORUM

WHO: Teams of four to six students from Luton secondary schools will make presentations to their peers, teachers and local / national decision-makers on a sustainability issue that affects their future;

WHAT: Students will learn how to make a strong case for their chosen sustainability issue and propose specific actions they'd like to see happen in their community. Decision-makers will comment and all vote a top priority;

WHY: Young people need to get better at arguing the case for what they want to see happen. With careful preparation by the "Youth for a Sustainable Luton" project, and a full afternoon's training supplied by Peace Child International facilitators this project offers Bedfordshire students an opportunity to hone their communications skills and their understanding of sustainability issues;

WHEN: We are planning to hold 2 trainings – The first option is at Queen Elizabeth School on Thursday 8th June. The second option would be at Stockwood Park on Friday 16th June. Both would run from 11-1.30.
